Testing FAQ's

Why are you requiring a test and not proof of vaccine?

Due to the potential for vaccinated individuals to contract and spread the virus, the safest option for having the 2021 NEIRA Annual Conference in person is to require all attendees to show proof of a negative COVID-19 test within 3 days of arrival to the conference, regardless of vaccine status.

I'm bringing a spouse/guest with me. Does he or she need to get tested?

Yes, if your spouse or guest is attending any portion of the conference (meals, sessions, etc.) they will also need to have a negative test within 3 days of arrival to the conference.

Will attendees be required to test every day?

No. Attendees are asked to only submit their test results 3 days prior to arrival at the Conference.

Are masks going to be required?

We will be following CDC, state of Massachusetts and local agency guidelines.

- If you are not fully vaccinated and aged 2 or older masks are required in indoor public places.
- If you are fully vaccinated, it is recommended that a mask be worn in public indoor settings in [areas of substantial or high transmission](#).
